DATE: Friday, August 18 through Sunday, August 20, 2017

TIMES: Friday- 9:00 a.m.; Saturday- 9:00 a.m.; Sunday- 10:00 a.m.

PRE-ENTRY: Entries paid in full and postmarked by August 7, 2017 are pre-entry \$5.00 per class. See Sunday shows for fees.

POST-ENTRY: Entries postmarked after August 7, 2017 or received at the show are post-entries \$7.00 per class.

FEES: \$10.00 per horse stall for the week
\$10.00 per overnight stall
\$10.00 per tack stall for the week (minimum of 2 horses per tack stall)

No stall applications accepted that are postmarked after August 7!

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

- a) *All exhibitors must purchase a membership to the Essex County Agricultural Society (\$30.00) which allows entry to the grounds for the extent of the fair (excludes grand stand and rides). Must show proof of membership to enter grounds or you will be charged daily entry (refunds at office with proof of membership). ***Application and membership fee must accompany all entry forms.***
- b) **Refer to Ag & Markets rules for “Animal Health Requirements for Admission to NYS and County Fairs”. A current Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) (Coggins) test is required. Current Rabies Vaccinations are required. Out of State exhibitors must also have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI). **The aforementioned should be included with entries along with copies of breed registrations where required.**
- c) *All horses stabled for the duration of fair are to be on grounds by 5 p.m. Tuesday, August 15 and remain until 7 p.m. Sunday, August 20 to be awarded premiums. 4-H horses are required to be stabled all week and will be considered first in stall designation because of limited stall space, the rest will be by first come first serve basis. **Please indicate on entry forms if you are 4-H.** This year stalls will be limited so there will be a lot of truck- ins, if you are only thinking of showing one or two days please consider trucking in. Please submit “Essex County Fair Horse Show Application” on page 8 prior to August 1.

GENERAL REGULATIONS (continued):

- e) *Beginner, Junior, and Senior riders must wear **approved** SEI/ASTM helmet and appropriate foot wear when ever mounted on a horse. All Friday and Saturday classes should be in formal show attire. Saturday Gymkhana tack optional, formal or informal attire. Sunday a.m. Gymkhana tack optional, formal or informal attire (T-Shirt or Polo Shirt appreciated).
- g) The Essex County Fair Horse Show Application Form is on page 8. The Friday Essex County Fair Horse Show and the Saturday Open Horse Show Entry Form is on page 9, and the Sunday Gymkhana Shows Entry Form is on page 10.
- h) **Please send Applications and all entries for Friday Essex County Fair Show, Saturday Open Horse Show and Sunday Gymkhanas, with fees (checks made out to Essex County Fair) and copies of Rabies, EIA, CVI, and Breed Registration papers to: Moreen Roy, Superintendent of Essex County Fair Horse Shows, 6060 Route 9N, Westport NY 12993. *Regulation covers Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. **Covers any horse entering grounds.
Horse show rules will be handed out and posted at the ring and on the barns.

PRIZES:

Rosettes for each class for placings 1st through 4th. High Point and Reserve Trophies for halter classes. Premiums are awarded to placings 1st through 4th. Premiums will be mailed out after the fair is over. Premiums will pay as follows: \$14, \$12, \$10, \$8.

DEFINITIONS: (Ages are as of January 1, 2017)

Lead Line: A rider 13 years of age or younger who needs to be led by an adult 18 years of age and older.

Beginner Walk/Trot: A rider that can walk-trot only.

Beginner Walk/Trot/Beginning to Canter: A rider who can walk/trot and is beginning to canter.

Junior: Rider who is ages 9-13 yrs.

Senior: Rider who is 14-18 years old

Youth Intermediate- Gymkhana- (takes place of out Beginner Canter Class)

Youth Open- Gymkhana – Junior & Senior Riders 9-18 that are not beginners

Adult Limited: A classification for Gymkhana only. This is for the adult who does not normally ride in Gymkhana.

Adults: Rider who is 19 yrs. of age or older.

Adult Intermediate- Adults – (NO reins to the ears, no kicking or slapping with reins)

Adult Open – Adult (Full blast!)

Pee Wee Hunter over Cross Rails: Beginner only cannot go in any other jumping classes.

Hunter Over Fences 2'0", Gamblers Choice, Handy Hunter, Hunters Pairs: All cross rail Jumps

Essex County Fair Friday & Saturday Horse Show Awards

High Point Awards

High Point will be awarded to the persons with high point scores in each division (English Classes, Western Classes, Trail Classes, and Jumping Classes.) Reserve will be awarded respectively to the persons with the second highest scores. Points will be calculated as follows: in classes with 6 or more entries, the top four placings (7-5-3-1); in classes with 5 or less entries, the top three placings (5-3-1), etc.

Trail High Point Award

To be awarded to the person with the highest score of all divisions, having completed Trail Class. Trophies for each Division.

High Point Jumping Award

Award will be given to the person with the highest point score for Jumping in classes indicated in class list under this award. A reserve award will be presented to the person with the second highest score in these classes.

Performance Award

An award will be given to the person who demonstrates excellence in horsemanship with obvious enjoyment of the sport in the following areas: Grooming, Training, and Presentation. Judge and show officials will determine winning of this award.

Sportsmanship Award

This award will be presented to the person who shows most kindness to his or her horse, shows enjoyment in showing, and gives support and encouragement to fellow riders. Judge and show officials will determine winner of this award.

Stall Award

To be awarded to the best decorated stall nearing the theme of "TBA". Only stalls rented for the week will be eligible. If you set up a display as a family or group, one award will be presented. Please indicate at bottom of entry form if you are planning to enter. There is no entry fee.
